

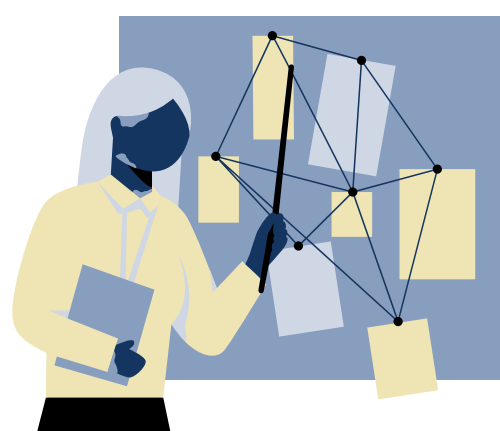


THE HISTORICAL PROCESS
